

**Dear Parents and Family Caregivers,**

Students learned that it is important to talk to a grown-up about how to avoid riding with an unsafe driver, including how to politely refuse a ride. They also learned what to do if they found themselves riding in a car, bus, van or truck with someone they think is not safe to drive. Please ask your child if he or she feels safe riding with all the drivers that drive him or her. Talk about what to do and who to call if he or she wants to avoid riding with someone that may not be safe to drive. Also, ask your child to show you what they would do if they found themselves riding in a car, bus, van or truck with someone they think is not safe to drive and then do this activity together.
